TENNESSEE CATTLEMEN'S ASSOCIATION AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION
AGENT AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING WORK IN 4-H BEEF PROGRAM

Instructions

I. Criteria For Selection

1. To be eligible for this award, the Extension Agent shall have worked three or more years with the UT Extension Service at the time of the Annual Convention of the Tennessee Cattlemen's Association at which the award is made.
2. An Extension Agent may win the award only one time.
3. The award shall be based on educational programs and activities related to the 4- H beef cattle project conducted in the current and previous two calendar years.
4. The Extension Agent should have a record of good performance related to his or her overall Extension Program.
5. Major factors in selection of the Extension Agent will be:
 - 5.A. Enrollment in the 4-H Beef Project and the participation of county 4-H'ers in county, district and state events.
 - 5.B. Educational activities and events related to 4-H Beef Project.
 - 5.C. County mass media educational program related to 4-H Beef Project. This program should utilize mass media available in the county.
 - 5.D. Involvement and utilization of volunteer leaders in 4-H Beef Project Groups.
 - 5.E. Interaction and/or involvement of other organizations, business groups, commodity groups and professionals that have cooperated in executing programs in the 4-H Beef Project.

II. Procedure For Selection

Entries are to be submitted to the respective Regional Extension Agricultural Program Leader. The Regional Agricultural Program Leaders will select the regional representative and forward the nominee to Dr. Troy Rowan by June 16 2023. trowan@utk.edu.

A state committee will select the state winner.

The committee will select the state winner from the nominees submitted from the three Extension Regional Offices. The Regional Program Leaders for Agriculture in each Region will be responsible for coordinating selection of one nominee and forwarding this nomination to the state committee:

An agent, person or county cattlemen's association or cattlemen's association may nominate any qualified Extension Agent. Any Regional Supervisory team may nominate an agent or may add supporting material to a nomination.

The attached nomination form will be used.

III. Award

The award will be recognition and a suitable plaque that will be presented at the Tennessee Cattlemen's Association Annual Convention Awards Program on July 21 2023 at the Sevierville Convention Center in Sevierville Tn. Each winner is expected to attend the annual convention of the Tennessee Cattlemen's Association
