The "Outstanding Cow-Calf Producer Award" will be presented by the Tennessee Cattlemen's Association to recognize an individual that has excelled in the areas of beef cattle production and marketing.

ELIGIBILITY

Each nominee can either be an individual producer or a partner. The award will be to the individual, not a firm. The nominee may be either a commercial cow/calf producer or purebred breeder.

The nominee must be a member of the Tennessee Cattlemen's Association but not a member of the Executive Committee.

An individual can only be the recipient of this award one time.

Each winner is expected to attend the annual convention luncheon of the Tennessee Cattlemen's Association January 24 2025 at the Embassy Suites Hotel Murfreesboro Tn.
