### **Rules**

1. Eligibility – all exhibitors 21 years of age or younger as of January 1, 2023, are eligible to show.
2. There will be divisions for registered heifers, commercial heifers, and steers.
3. Registered heifer classes will be broken by breed and age. Some breed classes have been sponsored. Others will be determined by the committee based on entries.
4. Commercial heifer and steer classes will be broken by weight.
5. Exhibitors must show their own animals unless they have more than one entry in a class.
6. Exhibitors must have original registration papers signifying ownership of registered heifers at check in.
7. The Eiffel Tower Classic will pay three places in each class.
8. Top 5 steers and heifers will be selected. Grand and reserve steer and heifer will receive a premium.
9. Showmanship divisions are divided by age (as of Jan 1, 2023) and will show as follows:
  - i. Senior Plus (up to 21 yrs. old)
  - ii. Senior II (11th & 12th Grades)
  - iii. Senior I (9th & 10th Grades)
  - iv. Junior High (7th & 8th Grade)
  - v. Junior (5th & 6th Grades)
  - vi. Explorer (4th Grade)
  - vii. Pee-Wee (3rd grade and Under)
  - viii. \*Animals used in showmanship classes must be owned by the exhibitor and also shown in class by that exhibitor. (Only exception is Pee-wee division.)
10. Animals must be under control of the exhibitor. Any animal that cannot be controlled or breaks away from the exhibitor more than twice during a class will be excused from the show ring.
11. The Eiffel Tower Classic committee will set classes, enforce all rules, and settle any disputes. All decisions of the committee are final.
